Collaboration between the College of Engineering and COLA earns the school \$1.5 million!


The university has been awarded a \$1.5 million grant from the US Department of Labor for "Rural Energy Network for Equitable Workforce and Economic Development," a partnership between COLA and the College of Engineering. 
