Dr. William R. Davie and Dr. Yuling Huang-Davie returned from traveling Southeast Asia as members of the US Fulbright Scholars Program, visiting the countries of Malaysia, Singapore, Brunei, and China.

The international exchange program allows for researchers and students from over 140 different countries to interact with each other and engage in cross-cultural dialogue.

Dr. Davie worked with a team of Malaysians to produce a comparative analysis on the Malaysian journalists new code of conduct and presented on media literacy and ethics.

Dr. Huang worked on developing and promoting master's and PhD programs in piano performance at a Malaysian university.

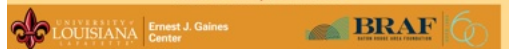

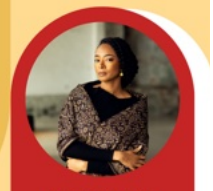



FLYING WORDS PROJECT is an American Sign Language (ASL) poetry troupe comprised of Deaf poet Peter Cook and hearing coauthor Kenny Lerner. They have performed ASL poetry together all over the world for forty years. Cook and Lerner have been the recipients of grants from the New York State Council of the Arts, the National Endowment for the Arts, and the Puffin Foundation and are the authors of four DVD anthologies, *The Year of the Walking Dogs* (1984-90), *the Can't Touch Tours* (1990-2003), and *Live at the Bowery Club* (2007) and *Flying Words Project: Live in Colorado* (2014.) Peter Cook is Associate Professor and Chair of the ASL Department at Columbia College Chicago, and Kenny Lerner is Senior Lecturer of History at the Rochester Institute of Technology National Technical Institute for the Deaf.





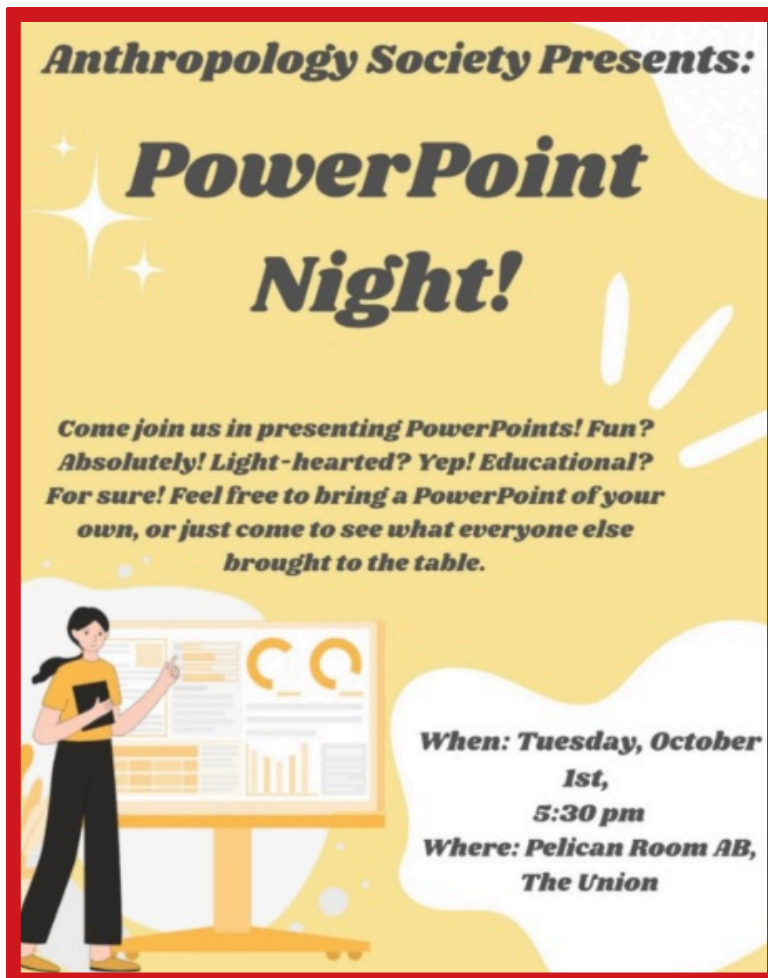
Investigating Poverty Point's Mound F

WITH DR. DIANA GREENLEE

In 2011, while acquiring data for Poverty Point's World Heritage nomination, Dr. Greenlee noted a suspicious rise in the woods north of the site's monumental core, an area rarely visited by park personnel or archaeologists. That rise has since been confirmed to be a previously unknown constructed earthwork. The "new-to-us" mound, Mound F, is described and the results of initial and ongoing investigations are presented.
